



We have always fostered a love for literacy in our Preschoolers as literacy is the foundation for all learning. This prepares children for future academic success.





### CHILD HEALTH ASSESSMENT FORMS

As a licensed childcare center, we are required to have up-to-date Child Health Assessment Forms according to the following schedule:

3 months to 18 months every 6 months 24 months to 60 months (5 years old) every 12 months School Age Children every 24 months

These forms are mandatory. Unfortunately, services may be suspended if they are not received. An email is sent to families 30 days prior to the form expiring from our Enrollment Specialist, Please submit the updated form right away.

### Annual Fees that Parent's' should remember:

- 2. Graduation Fees (Preschoolers)
- 3. Summer Camp Activity Fees (School Agers)
- 4. Preschool Summer Trip Fees
- 5. Transportation Fees (Woodlyn Academy Families only)



The above listed fees are applied each school year to applicable parent accounts. Most fees are applied as a weekly payment plan to minimize the total cost. Please be sure to review your Annual Calendar (which is also a mandatory fundraiser of \$10 per enrolled family) to see when these fees will be applied to your account and when the events will take place. Working together to lower the cost for parents is always our priority and we try to keep our parents informed. Please reach out to your sites Enrollment Specialist if you have not received a calendar or if you have any questions.



WHY A VALID EMAIL ADDRESS AND CELL PHONE NUMBER IS SO IMPARTANT: Emails and messages through MyProCare are our primary source of communication with parents. We also send text messages when we are unable to reach you by phone in the event of an emergency. Please be sure that the center has all of your current contact information as well as that of anyone you have listed as an Emergency Contact.



Woodlyn Academy Organization participates in the CACFP program which enables us to provide nutritional meals and snacks for your children. All families are required to complete a CACFP Income Eligibility and a CACFP Enrollment form annually. To make this process more convenient for families we use KidKare which allows you to complete these forms electronically. You may receive an email invitation to create an account and Ms. Kristen at Woodlyn or complete these forms, please do so right away.


# A Message from Our Owners
